Pastor's Corner

I recently have been pondering serendipity. Serendipity is defined as; "the occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way". I have been reflecting how, in my many travels and life changes, God has always seen me through, usually by bringing someone into my life; a presence to offer me security, hope, assistance, guidance, or just companionship to get me through and guide me along. When I ponder them, I have to wonder how my life would be different if these encounters had not occurred. If I had been at a different place, or just was not open to them.

There are many instances of this in the Bible.
