It has been an exciting week as we hosted the Praying Pelicans mission team once again. Our group this year was from Pittsburg, PA and there were 26 high energy teenagers camped out here for a week. Every time I came here, they were running around the church and the parking lot, playing games, and enjoying our facility. Apparently, their energy was not limited to fun and games, for while they were here, they and the other team completed the work needed to close 5 more cases and get 5 families back to safe and stable living conditions after the flooding last year. They were grateful for your hospitality and reminded us that this allowed them to do the work they came here hoping to do.

At our recent Pike County Relief Services, we recognized that it has been a year since our area was impacted by that event. Also, we were informed that since then 72 cases have been resolved. That is 72 families that have had their residences restored and have allowed them to get back to some form of a normal existence. That is a great achievement but there is still more need and still more cases to resolve. More teams are coming, and our Relief Services committees are still working hard to resolve cases and restore families. Continue to support them in prayer and look for ways to put your energy into restoring the lives of others.



### ***Community Dinner Success!!***

We were blessed to give out 141 dinners, 82 bags of groceries, and 43 bags of school supplies during the July Community Dinner. A huge thank you to all those who donate their time, money, and prayers to the dinner. Without you this outreach would not be possible.

### ***Veterans Donation Drive***

Our Missions Team is collecting supplies to donate to the Veteran's Transitional Housing Center. The facility has 25 units that are made available to homeless veterans as they transition into permanent housing. Items most requested by the center are cleaning products, paper products, coffee, laundry soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, towels, and twin size sheets. The donation box is under the bulletin board as you enter the building.
